Raymond-Knowles Elementary School Parent Involvement Policy

• For the 2013-2014 school year, it has not yet been determined how Title I program funds will be used. When these decisions are made, parents will be informed via the school newsletter, Mr. Johnson's blog, and the annual Title I parent meeting.

• The academic assessments used by the school and each students' results will be explained during parent conferences after each of the first three quarters of the school year.

• The school-parent compact will be distributed and reviewed with parents and students at back to school night.
